DEADLINE May 13th, 2018–Must be POSTMARKED BY May 7th, 2018 (NO EXCEPTIONS)

To be considered for either the CSHSRA member award or interview scholarship, members must submit the following:

Checklist

- _____ 1. Completed application due by May 13th – must be postmarked by May 7th.
- _____ 2. Recommendation form completed by principal/counselor (*home school see application note)
Applicant is responsible to make sure school sends this by due date!
- _____ 3. Transcripts
- _____ 4. Essay
- _____ 5. Interview with scholarship review board at State Finals

FOUR YEAR CSHSRA MEMBERS (MUST FILL OUT FORM & TURN IN ON TIME)

The four-year member award will be awarded \$500 upon completion of the above referenced forms, including the school form and transcripts. There will not be an interview for this award.

CSHSRA Member Applicants will be invited to an interview with an independent committee made up of people from outside the CSHSRA organization during State Finals. A minimum of \$3000 will be given out depending on the committee's decision.

Performance based awards are as follows:

- 1st and 2nd round WINNERS at STATE FINALS \$100/event
- Queens contestant winners in each category \$100
- Year-end All-Around GIRL and BOY \$250
- State Finals All-Around GIRL and BOY \$250

The scholarship and award winners will need to furnish the CSHSRA Scholarship Committee with the name and address of the college that they are enrolled in. Written requests must be made to receive all scholarship/award money. You must have completed high school and be enrolled in a trade school, post secondary vocational school, college, or university. This information must be in writing and submitted to the scholarship committee address:

Scholarship payment will be paid upon request (Member must send a letter asking for the money, Student ID, College Address and proof of schooling registration). All funds must be applied for within 4 years after high school graduation or the money will go back into the Scholarship Account. Requests will be reviewed and checks mailed to the school/College.
